

### 21A. STAFF

This staff is a fine example which relates to, but does not directly duplicate, an example in the Brenthurst Collection. Both staffs are surmounted by a tortoise, with snake forms on the shafts. The representation of animals differ, and the Horstmann example has a protruding carved design on its shaft with an attached chain which does not appear in any Brenthurst examples. It is important to collect objects which are similar in this way in order to obtain a broader view of artistic production, and to be able to start making connections through comparisons.








Above : Detail of upper shaft Below : Detail of lower shaft
